

PROTECTING THE RIGHTS OF A SUSPECT UPON ARREST AND DENTENTION

THE RIGHTS OF A DETAINEE

1. Be treated humanely and with respect for the inherent dignity of a human being
2. Be informed of the reason for detention and any charges against him/her
3. Not to be subjected whatsoever to any form of torture or cruel, inhumane degrading treatment or punishment
4. Be allowed to access medical treatment including private treatment at his/her request



Present an arrest warrant to the suspect before arrest



Allow suspect to contact family or lawyer



Peacefully arrest and take the suspect to court or custody



Freely give bond to suspect if he or she asks
